







Histogram for scaled questions



3.12) What could your instructor do in the future to make this a better class?

- expectations of what is considered good on assignments were unclear. so clearer rubrics and/or feedback for assignments.
- Everything is alright, but I guess he could make the class before a due date a work day.
- Have all due dates and assignment instructions clearly written on blackboard.
- He is quite the harsh grader, maybe lighten up a bit, or be far more clear on expectations for a above average grade
- I couldn't say, everything has been amazing so far. An additional class to cover more of concept art would be a great improvement on this course. There's so much to cover.
- I don't think there's any major problems in his class because it's already great.
- I felt the instructor assumed I had experience with tablets in photoshop which I didn't. Which causes me to be slower than most students. Also in case of homework assignments due I would prefer if he gave us workdays not enterupted by class assignments that are mandatory.
- I have felt that he can tend to be pretty dismissive of peoples comments, or he can put down people for seemingly mild things like forgetting a tablet.
- I think giving a little bit of wiggle room in terms of grading. With some of the assignments, as we're mostly all beginners, having a little bit of a better understanding of our current abilities and grade with that mindset. However, the grading isn't unfair at all.
- I think if he put more emphasis on improving drawing abilities it would take pressure off of these drawing heavy projects. I find myself getting somewhat paralyzed on some of these assignments because I don't think I can draw at a level that will lead to a successful end product.
- I think providing more examples of the work quality he expects would help. More structure to the sketchbook assignments would help too. Sometimes he'd say do one thing then change it by the next class. Perhaps having the week by week sketchbook assignments in the syllabus would help students be prepared.
- I think that in the future there should be more in class work that will help prepare for each large assignment. Even though there are exercises, they provide little help for the main 6 assignments. Also, it would be nice to have straightforward examples of what the instructor wants in the projects. Even when questions are asked, the expectations are a bit ambiguous, and people might get docked points for doing things they think is okay.
- I think that this is already a fantastic class. I would love to see a list of additional readings and activities that we could do outside of class to deepen our learning.
- I would maybe have him use some time in class to work on lectures and whatnot, and other times where we could have more in class work on our assignments. Since this is a two hour class, i think it could e implemented.
- It does take him a while to explain what he is looking for on assignments, perhaps making a list of all requirements in assignment pages would help clarify what the teacher expects for the assignment.
