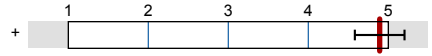

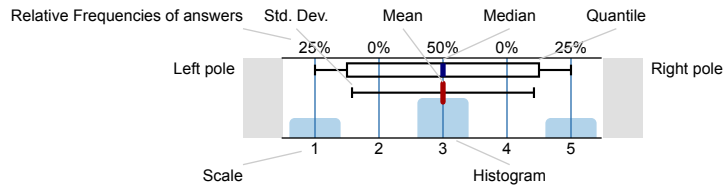

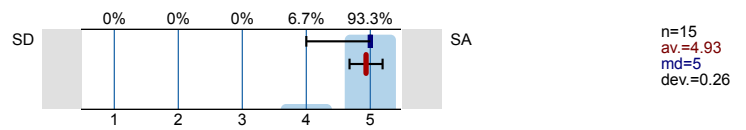

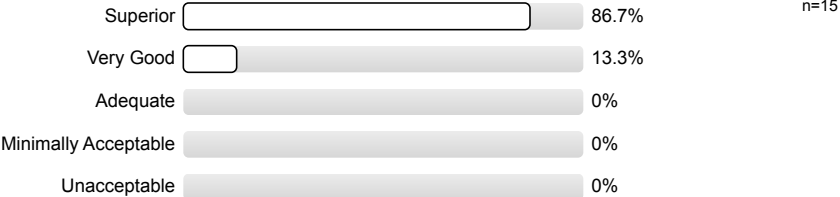

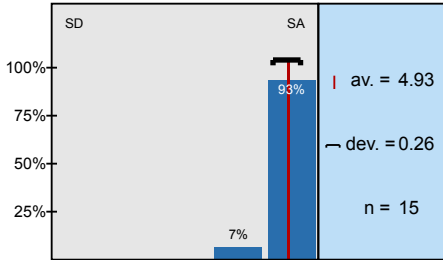

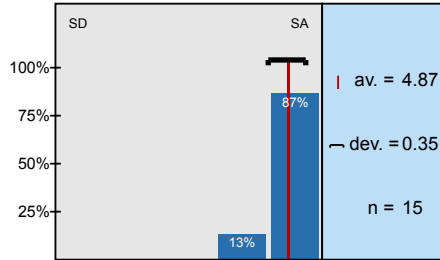


Histogram for scaled questions

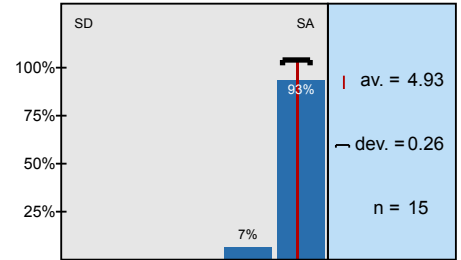
