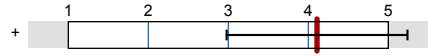

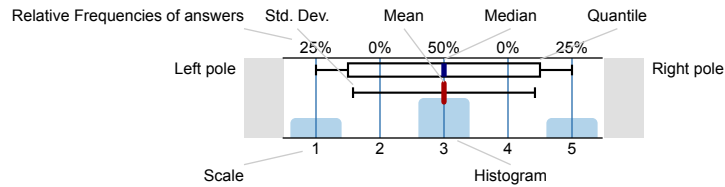

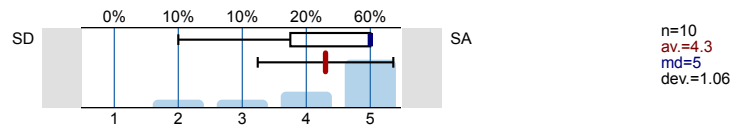

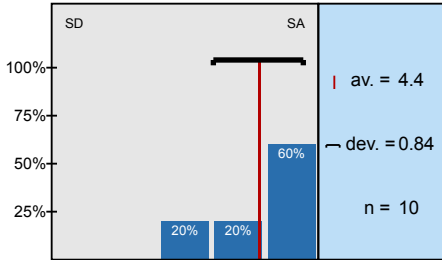

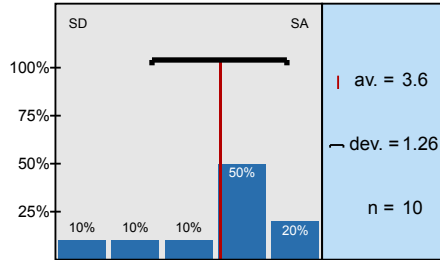


Histogram for scaled questions

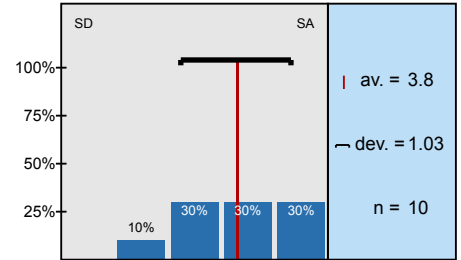

- Be more coherent in his explanations.
- I believe this class is fine as it is, it works well with the online system and I don't feel fatigued even after three hours of class. The one thing I would change is the use of Black Board to post our work, I hated the editing system but that has been changed as of yesterday.
- I feel overall that this course needs a little more attention paid to the students in the realm of maybe meeting for an hour in the middle of the week so that some techniques could be discussed. Although each team is meeting separately I think as a whole each team should discuss processes so that things could flow better. I think that more resources are necessary.
- I think it would be beneficial to have a Digital calendar for the semester. It serves as a Goodway to follow through with the class and help students be prepared. I know that I am constantly following the calendars for classes, and it is a helpful way to visually organize the class.
- More learning sources and guides, actual guidelines instead of the "go do something" attitude.
- Perhaps have a resource library of different tutorials in case some students need refreshers on different modelling or texturing techniques
- Suggest a few tutorial videos for project work would help me a lot during class but I manage to find them myself.
- other than clearing some instructions in the beginning nothing that can come to mind.

- The instructor was very helpful and I wasn't lost at all because of him and his use of class time and discord.
- There needs to be more attention paid to providing feedback on the little things happening.
- Weekly check-ups put too much pressure on students. Even 545 and 493 have biweekly check-ups to keep us stress free while doing our work. Only/mostly seniors take this class. We have a lot of classes and projects to juggle and we can't always work on something that week. Instead of hearing "it doesn't look good" I'd much rather hear "what" specifically doesn't look good about something, what kind of changes they'd like to see and how it should be done. I'd like to be presented with new tools, brushes, programs, methods and tutorials on how to do them instead of "go online find something". I'm already paying a bunch of money for somewhat decent online education that is definitely not monitored well enough (not like it can be monitored well enough while online), I don't need to be pointed towards google for

further education. What is the point of having to work on both Trello AND BLACKBOARD!? It's like having two facebook accounts. Pick one and go with it. Furthermore, taking the "team lead" position from students and making it so that we're not even being graded as a proper team and doing SEPARATE parts of a scene is the WORST idea possible. Some of us excel in modeling while others in texturing. Some in characters, some in assets/environment. Some in organic forms some in more mechanical things. Not everyone is trying to be a generalist. Now we pretend to be in a team while not even communicating that much to make sure our pieces go together, the design differences are popping out and we have no actual leadership going on between us nor team leading skills improving because we are not getting to be our team lead.
