




Histogram for scaled questions

^{3.12)} What could your instructor do in the future to make this a better class?

- Be more clear and concise with what he wants out of us. Hold everyone to the same standard.
- Crack down on class disruptions, there are particular students that distract the rest and slow the class down. Also if the lectures were available outside of class.
- Give us a little bit more time in class to work on assignments.
- He could check some assignments more that he said he would more often
- He could have a few more examples and offer some in class time to check some students work to assist in everyone's learning of the material.
- He could probably be more considerate toward people who are taking the class that have a lower skill range than other people. These people could've still worked hard on the projects.
- He could remind us where we should be during an project.
- I feel like while him going over what we need to be learning in lecture during assignments is good for our overall comprehension, I wish the lectures would move faster to keep up with the project dates. On one of our last assignments, the character sheet assignment, he continued covering character inspiration/design at a snails pace while only pushing us to finish the lineart and coloring of our character in the last week. I'm certain if I'd have kept with the expected pace I never would have finished the project on time.
- I think that more critique is good for learning how to improve even more.
- I think that posting more resources on blackboard in case students need a refresher while working.
- I think the instructor could make the rules on Blackboard a little more clear since there are a few things that seem to get overshadowed or are not explained enough in detail.
- I wish it was smaller so that he could work more closely with each student.
- I wish that he could help out the students in terms of showing them how to improve on in terms of the art and the assignment requirements are very convoluted and should be more simplified for us. Also, the grading is very rough again and I wished that he could not give me C's in all of my assignments like it was in 230 it's back again.
- I would check our drawing books a little more often to make sure we are doing it. There were a couple weeks I fell behind on them due to other class' work and I need to catch up.
- I would say manage the students that act rowdy every now and then.
- I would say that he should give clearer establishment of progress that needs to be done since stages of work that he mentions should be done very from person to person and their speed with line work, coloring, etc
- Improvements could include the distribution of free food.
- In the future, this class could have more examples and demonstrations.

- Keep at least one of the lights on so we can see the keyboards keys properly.

- Maybe dive into the specifics more. Although I have had more personal experience before coming into this class, I think going more indepth would be good for the class, should time allow it.
- More exercises
- Perhaps shorten the earlier assignments (make them less points?) so we can jump into the character sheet/story boarding sooner. Know what all the sketches will be per week from the start of the course to give us more freedom to draw when we find the time.
- Put individual sketchbook assignments on blackboard instead of notes exclusive with list of needed files turn in for each assignment. Put notes on blackboard (optional). More extra credit options.
- The instructor could include more in-class exercises and/or extra credit exercises with the tablet for each topic that is taught.
- The only thing I can say is that he doesn't always explain things very well, so maybe just explaining things in a simpler and more understandable way at all times would be good for the students.
- The only thing I would advise the instructor to do to make this a better class is to write a little bit of notes in his slide show presentations to help give us more detail about specific things in the lecture.
- There's not much more needed. Maybe do more with the sketchbooks I guess.
- communicate what is due when better ie: homework, sketchbook
- focus more on qualitative assignment over quantity of the assignment
- i think just too much time is spent on lecture/ practices that there is not much "in class time" to do assignments.
